Here are just a couple of reminders and some new information that are particularly appropriate for consideration to ensure that you and your neighbors enjoy the upcoming months!!

- The Postal service has asked that we all remember to keep the trees surrounding the mailboxes trimmed so that the Postal deliverers can access the mailbox. Also, in winter, please remove snow build up around mailboxes so that again, the postal deliverers can access the mailbox easily.
- Fall is a great time for property improvements and enhancements, please keep in mind the following guidelines. Property modifications including additions to the home, or additions of pools, sheds, decks, etc. require approval by the Board of Directors of the WHA. Requests for authorizations for improvements must be mailed to: Wheatstone Homeowner's Association, P.O. Box 33, Campbelltown, PA 17010
- Garbage and trash collections Just a reminder, trash should not be placed by the street until the
 night prior to pickup. And please remember to retrieve your garbage cans after collection.
 Article VII of the WHA Bylaws requires that your trash containers be stored out of sight, so
 please keep them in your garage or behind your house, if possible. Regarding recyclable items –
 On windy days, please try to secure lightweight materials to reduce the likelihood of the wind
 scattering these materials. Your help in keeping the streets of the neighborhood clean is
 appreciated.
- Selling your home? Please remember to tell your real estate agent that you will need a resale certificate to sell your home. If you are selling your home independently, you will also need a resale certificate. Please contact Marie Bauer to obtain the certificate. You can send any correspondence to:

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- Reminder: The posted speed limits within Wheatstone are 25 MPH. The North Londonderry Township Police Department will enforce this speed limit.
- Reminder to all residents: The concrete swales are not intended as play areas for the children of the neighborhood especially during and after heavy rains. Some of the concrete swales within

the development are privately owned by residents and are not common areas. Please be respectful of individual homeowner's property.
